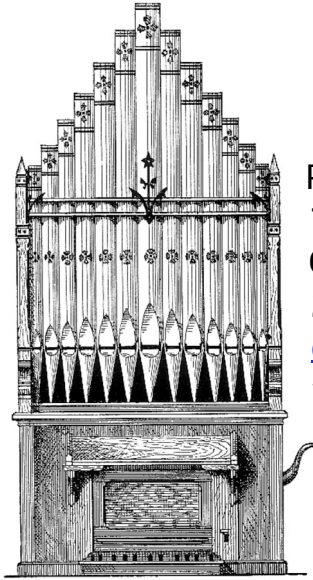

George Stevens c. 1840

Formerly of the South Windham Community Church

Great: 58 notes GGG, AAA to f3

8' Open Diapason  
8' Dulciana (TF)  
8' Stopped Diapason (Chimney FLute)  
4' Principal  
4' Flute (Chimney Flute)  
2 2/3' Twelfth  
2' Fifteenth  
8' Cremona (now a Keraulophone) (TF)

Swell: 58 notes GGG, AAA to f3

8' Open Diapason (TF)  
8' Stopped Diapason (TF)  
8' Swell Bass (GGG, AAA to TE)  
4' Principal (TF)  
8' Hautbois (TF)

Pedal: 13 notes GGGG, AAAA - GGG

16' Bourdon

The organ is in very poor condition especially the Great pipework but is ultimately restorable for the right situation. It was modified to a "C" compass organ in the 1880s when it was moved to the South Windham Church. All the original action is still in place, just the notes below CC were removed from the manuals. The pedal was rescaled to a C compass.

Asking Price: \$18,000.
