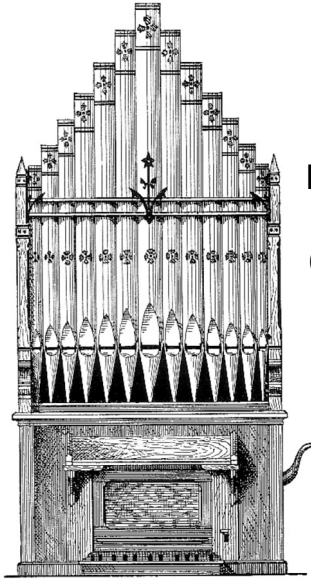

HISTORIC PIPE ORGANS FOR SALE

Lathrop C. Tilton c. 1865

L. C. Tilton was a Maine organ builder in East Livermore, Maine. He built at least 4 instruments that we know of with three of them remaining. Tilton was also a pipe maker and supplied pipes to other builders. This instrument is the largest of the three remaining Tilton organs.

Specification:

Manual: 56 notes enclosed (All stops are full compass unless noted)

8' Open Diapason
8' Clarabella (Melodia) (TC)
8' Stopped Diapason Bass (12 notes)
8' Keraulophone
8' Dulciana (TC)
8' Dulciana Bass (12 notes)
4' Principal
4' Flute (Melodia)
2' Fifteenth

Pedal: 18 notes

16' Subbass

Pedal and Keys

Pedal Check

14' high (center 12' 7" sides)

9' 4" wide

5' 7" deep (plus 36" for the bench and pedal)

This organ is in very rough condition and needs a complete restoration. It would be possible to extend the pedal to 25 or 27 notes. Other changes are not recommended.
